Hilarious night of satirical songs at Cinnabar with Roy Zimmerman

PETALUMA, CA – Roy Zimmerman has shared a stage with everyone from George Carlin to Bill Clinton. Now he's coming to Cinnabar Theater in Sonoma County so local folks can enjoy the hilarious satirist who has delighted audiences on NPR, HBO, MTV and nationwide.

"Don't miss '**Roy Zimmerman Offers Bad Advice**' on **Sunday, November 3** at 7:00 p.m.," says Cinnabar's artistic director, Elly Lichenstein. "You won't believe how much fun you'll have hearing him sing about war, ignorance and greed."

"Zimmerman displays a lacerating wit and keen awareness of society's foibles that bring to mind a latter-day Tom Lehrer," asserts the *LA Times*. Like Lehrer, Zimmerman incites laughter with his smart, incisive songs. He's released 13 uproarious albums in 20 years, and millions of people have enjoyed his funny videos on YouTube. Even the *New York Times* praises the "**contagious irreverence**" of his music.

"Zimmerman is a guy on the left skewering folks on the right with rapier-sharp lyrics," adds *Sing Out! Magazine*. "Underneath the caustic satire is a man who is surprisingly optimistic."
